




Drought Impact Types:

- ~ Delineates dominant impacts
- A = Agricultural (crops, pastures, grasslands)
- H = Hydrological (water)

Intensity:

- None
- Yellow = D0 Abnormally Dry
- Orange = D1 Moderate Drought
- Brown = D2 Severe Drought
- Red = D3 Extreme Drought
- Maroon = D4 Exceptional Drought
