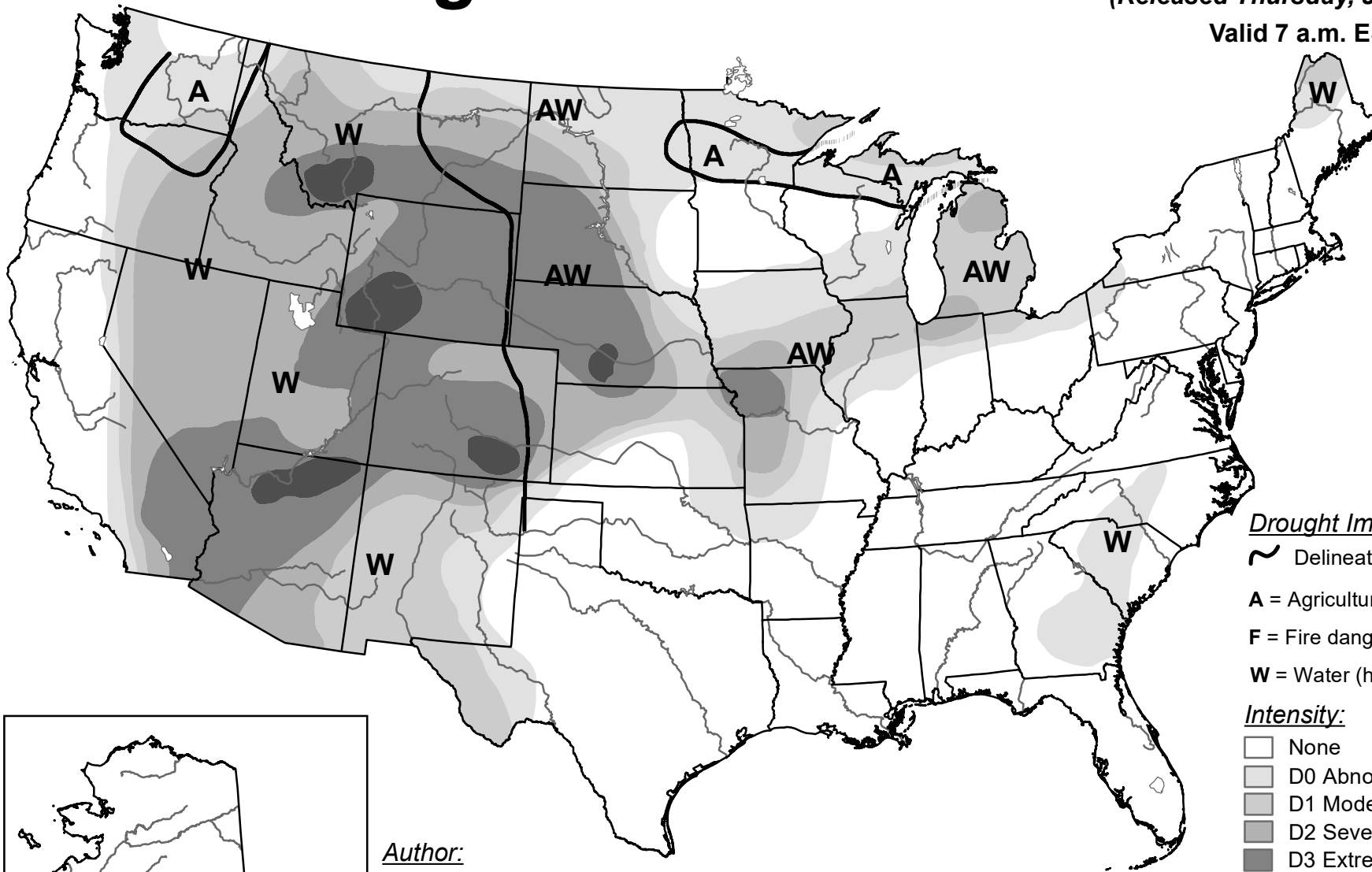

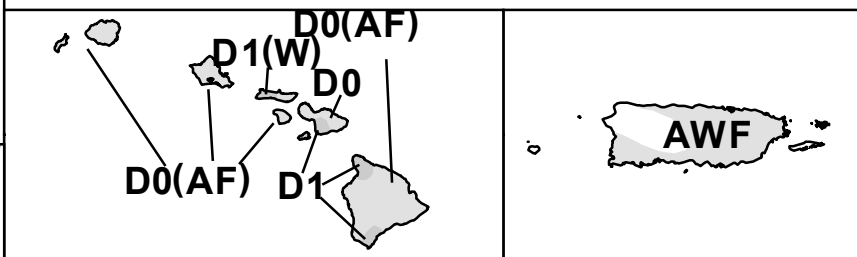
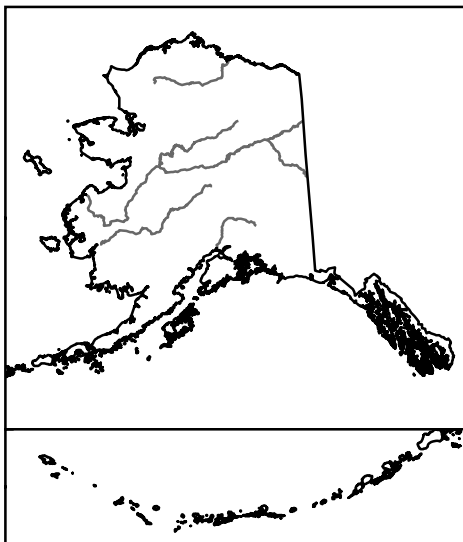
Drought Impact Types:
